In 1992, Prudence Nobantu Mabele (July 21, 1971 - July 10, 2017) became one of the first women in South Africa to disclose her HIV status. Prudence set a precedent to encourage other women with HIV to discuss their status with loved ones, to live without shame, to seek treatment, and to lead happy and fulfilled lives.
